# **Types of Cooperatives**

The two major types of Cooperatives are:

- (i) Agricultural Cooperatives and
- (ii) Non-agricultural Cooperatives.

### **Agricultural Cooperatives**

Specifically organized to cater for agricultural sector needs. Agricultural cooperatives can be found in consumption, production, marketing and credit.

### **Forms of Agricultural Cooperatives**

- (i) Agricultural Producer Cooperatives
- (ii) Agricultural Produce Marketing Cooperatives
- (iii) Agricultural Thrift and Credit Cooperatives
- (iv) Agricultural Consumer Cooperatives
- (v) Multipurpose Cooperative Societies

## **Non- Agricultural Cooperatives**

Exist among craftsmen, artisans, small business concerns, civil servants. Developed in the areas of services, supply of goods and credit.

#### Based on functions and activities

- **1.** Agricultural Cooperatives
- 2. Service Cooperatives Marketing Financing Insurance
- **3.** Consumer Cooperatives
- 4. Industrial Cooperatives
- **5.** Multipurpose cooperatives

Note: No. 2 -5 are non Agricultural Cooperatives.
