- north space should be left between the views on a drawing to appoint modate dimension and notes without crowding.
- | The spaning should be planned before beginning.
- III. Haden detail should only be used where it is essential for a complete description of the object but it should not be used for dimensioning.
- Application of the view separately since it wastes time.

  Menturements can often be made on two or more views simultaneously or projected from one to another as soon as they are made therefore built all the views together.
