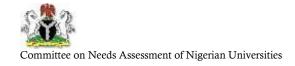

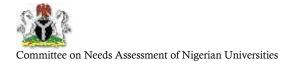

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#### **INTRODUCTION**

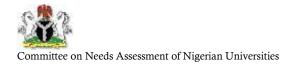
#### **NEEDS ASSESSMENT OF NIGERIAN UNIVERSITIES**

The Federal Government is determined to be proactive in addressing challenges in our institutions before they become issues of contention. To achieve this objective, Government has set up a Committee to assess specific needs of universities with the intent to determining priority areas to deploy resources.

The Needs Assessment involves an inventory of all physical facilities for teaching and learning, learning resources ranging from lecture theatres, laboratories, workshop, studios etc as well as municipal service (roads, water, electricity, security, health, recreational facilities etc.) The Committee will also assess staff/student ratios, staff and student population in relation to available facilities so as to identify the areas of pressure and how resources can be channelled in order to address critical needs. The information will also enable Government to clearly identify areas where the private sector can be encouraged to invest in the universities.

Attached is the Template for Data Capture which Universities are required to complete as vividly as possible to ensure that a comprehensive and accurate report can be generated on the conditions of the public universities in Nigeria.

In view of the above, you are kindly requested to complete the Template; ensuring correctness of data provided. The expected returns will be both hard and soft copies. Kindly stamp and sign the hard copies. Please note that Vice Chancellors are to take full responsibility for the integrity of data provided.

- ii. Give a detailed inventory of learning resources, with particular reference to their relevance and serviceability;
- iii. Compile the number of teaching staff by academic qualification and programme, indicating whether they are engaged on full-time, part-time or adjunct basis;
- iv. Compile a list of non-teaching staff and their disposition in each University;
- v. Compile a list of full-time students in each programme (undergraduate as well as postgraduate) across all levels;
- vi. Identify the number of institutions, students and programmes involved in part-time and approved affiliations;
- vii. Identify the number of on-campus hostels in each university and categorise them by ownership and capacity vis-à-vis the students' population;
- viii. Give the status of municipal facilities in each university and the requirements for their provision, upgrade and maintenance;
- ix. Examine any other matter which in the opinion of the Committee is relevant to the revitalization of our universities; and
- x. Submit a comprehensive report, making clear and detailed recommendations that are immediately actionable by Government.


