## CONCURRENT FATAL THEILERIA MUTANS AND TRYPANOSOMA VIVAX INFECTIONS IN WHITE FULANI (ZEBU) CATTLE IN NIGERIA

## **ABSTRACT**

An outbreak of a disease characterised by respiratory distress, lymph gland enlargement, hydrothorax, hydropericardium, anaemia and icterus in White Fulani (Zebu) Cattle is described. An intercurrent infection with Trypanosoma vivax appeared to have aggravated the severe and fatal Theileria mutans infection
