WILDLIFE EXTENSION SERVICES AND FACILITIES AS MANAGEMENT TOOLS IN NIGERIA.

ABSTRACT

The needs and problems of Wildlife extension services particularly in the rural settings of Nigeria are discussed. The strongholds of wildlife resources are in the rural areas. A vast majority of the rural dwellers depend on several species of Wildlife for animal protein 1ntake. Effective protection has been a major obstacle in the actual practice of wildlife management in Nigeria. "Managing the rural publics is considered to deserve as much as 80% of all the efforts in wildlife project areas. Depreciative human behaviours in wildlife project areas epitomize a basic issue: the issue of publics that have neither accepted nor consented to wildlife conservation. Adequate provision of realistic offers to local people must be made as trade-offs for wildlife-related problems which they have to face. Departments involved in conservation must come up with well-defined management actions especially local assistance such as employment opportunities and provision of bore holes means of transportation, roads and road maintenance, electricity and sscur1ty to attract rural public support.
