**CONCURRENT FATAL *THEILERIA* MUTANS AND
TRYPANOSOMA VIVAX INFECTIONS IN WHITE FULANI

ABSTRACT

An outbreak of a disease characterised by respiratory distress, lymph gland enlargement, hydrothorax, hydropericardium, anaemia and icterus in White Fulani (Zebu) Cattle is described. An intercurrent infection with *Trypanosoma vivax* appeared to have aggravated the severe and fatal *Theileria mutans* infection
