


INTRODUCTION




Figure 2: FUNAAB full-time Undergraduate Student's Growth Rate from 1998/1989 to 2011/2012 Academic Sessions







Figure 4: FUNAAB First Degree Graduate Output from 2006/2007 to 201112012 Academic Sessions









Figure 5: FUNAAB Undergraduate Graduation Pattern from 1988/1989 to 201112012 Academic Sessions

Figure 6: Graduate Output by Class of Degree and Gender for 2011/2012 Academic Session




Figure 7: First Class Graduates from 2007/2008 to 2011/2012 Academic Sessions



Figure 8: Postgraduate Student Output from 1997/1998 to 2011/2012 Academic Session



Figure 9: Postgraduate Student Output by College for 2011/2012 Academic Session





Figure 10: FUNAAB Graduation ProfIle for 2011/2012 Academic Session

Figure 11: Academic Staff by Rank and Gender as at September, 2012




Figure 12: Academic Staff Mix by Rank in Percentage as at September, 2012





Figure 14: Academic Staff by Gender as at September, 2012




Figure 15: Academic Staff Age Distribution as at September, 2012



Figure 16: Senior Non-Teaching Staff as at September, 2012








Figure 17: Age Distribution of Senior Non-Teaching Staff as at September, 2012




Figure 18: Junior Non-Teaching Staff as at September, 2012








Figure 19: Age Distribution of Junior Staff as at September, 2012




Figure 20: Percentage Distribution of Non-Teaching Staff by Cadre and Gender as at September, 2012



Figure 21: Staff by Category for 2011/2012 Academic Session



Figure 22: University Library Holdings (New Acquisition) as at September, 2012











Figure 23: University Library Holdings as at September, 2012

Figure 24: Patients Treated at the University Health Services in Percentages from 2006/2007 to 2010/2011 Academic Sessions








Figure 25: Patients Treated at the University Health Services by Category in 2010/2011 Academic. Session



Figure 26: Emergency Cases Treated at the University Health Services from 2006/2007 to 2010/2011 Academic Sessions


