CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMMES


The regional center runs a number of programme aimed at developing capacity for integrated water re sources management in the region. They include spe cialized workshops, short-term courses and long-term courses. The workshops are basically demand-driver to tackle identified problems in the water sector.


The short-term courses are 3-days modular trainin organized for targeted groups in the water sector, thes kind of courses include:

- Climate Change and IWRM
- 2. Surface water Development and IWRM
- Groundwater Development and IWRM
- 4. Gender Mainstreaming and IWRM
- 5. Community Participation and IWRM
- 6. Integrated River Basin Management
- 7. Rural Water Sanitation and IWRM
- 8. Environmental Health for Sustainable Livelihood
- 9. Water Governance, Administration and Finance

The long-term courses are more specialized professional training for high level manpower in the water sector. They include: Post Graduate Diploma (12 months) and Master of Science (18 months) in the following areas of specialization:

- 1. Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM)
- 2. Sanitation and Hygiene Promotion
- 3. Water Quality Management
- 4. Irrigation and Drainage Technology
- 5. Dams and Reservoir Management
- 6. Hydrogeology and Drilling Technology
- 7. River and Watershed Sedimentation and Hydraulics.9





BACKGROUND

NWRCBNet-SW, the National Water Resources Capacity Building Network for South West Nigeria was established on 18th April, 2010 after the signing of a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between the National Water Resources Institute, Kaduna and the University of Agriculture, Abeokuta. This is pursuant to the directive of the National Council on Water Resources for the establishment of the National Water Resources Capacity Building network (NWRCBNet) on 13th July, 2006. A regional coordinating centre was thereafter established in the University and charged with the responsibility of coordinating capacity development in the water sector through education, training, research and information dissemination in six (6) states of south west Nigeria. The states include Lagos, Ogun, Oyo, Osun, Ekiti and Ondo states.

To promote effective partnership for education, training, research and information dissemination on water resources development and management with a view of engendering integrated water resources management (IWRM) and ecosystem sustainability in the south west states of Nigeria.

Cardinal Objectives

The Objectives of NWRCBNet are to:-

- Ensure appropriate and sustainable manpower development for water resources development and management throughout the region.
- 2. Strengthen Institutions and Human capacity through partnerships for the successful imple-

- mentation of Integrated Water Resources Management in the region.
- Enhance cooperation among Capacity Building Institutions (CBIs) in the region for Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM).
- Facilitate applied research and demand driven training and education in IWRM amongst CBIs and water agencies (WAs) in the region.

NETWORK ACTIVITIES

The activities of the Network shall be to plan, de velop, conduct and manage specific trainings and applied research activities in the South West geo political zone of Nigeria as follows:

- i. Carry out periodical SWOT analysis and institutional assessment for capacity development of Hach Water Agencies and Herselia.
- it. Develop effective matering-ratio to carry out core functions of the Agencies and Departments
- ii Carry out training needs assessment exer cises to determine trimediate short and long term training required in the water sector
- iv. Empare the annual meetings of all the part nors coordinated by NVRL NVRL will report activities to the National Technica Committee annually.
- Carry out participatory development of planned works and implementation
- vi Carry out joint Research and project proposals to solve identified problems in the water sector
