

Students' Enrolment & Staff Profile

3.1 Students' Enrolment

The Postgraduate and Undergraduate Schools currently have students' population of Seventeen thousand, Six hundred and Fifty Four (17,654), distributed across different programmes.

3.1.1 Postgraduate Students' Enrolments for 2014/2015 Academic Session

The Postgraduate School currently has a student population of One thousand, six hundred and nine (1609) distributed across the different programmes.

In the year under review, the College of Physical Sciences has the highest Postgraduate Students' enrolment of 331 distributed across its 5 Departments, followed by College of Agricultural Management and Rural Development with enrolment of 257, while the College of Veterinary Medicine has the least postgraduate students' enrolment of 14.

3.1.2 Undergraduate Students' Enrolment

The Undergraduate School currently has a student population of Fifteen thousand, Four hundred and Eighty (15,480) distributed across the different programmes.

In the year under review, College of Engineering has the least undergraduate students' enrolment of 833 across different levels and Departments while College of Animal Science has the highest undergraduate students' enrolment of 2,532. It is note-worthy to remark that undergraduate students' enrolment by gender shows that Male enrolment has the highest enrolment value across the Colleges except in the three colleges listed below:


- (i) College of Biosciences has male enrolment of 472 and female enrolment of 612;

(iii) College of Management Science has male enrolment of 1,055 and female enrolment of 1,137.






Fig. 3.1: Undergraduate Students' Enrolment by College

3.1.3 Undergraduate Output by College

A total of Two thousand five hundred and eighty-eight (2,588) candidates graduated with various Classes of Degree during the 2014/2015 Session under review.


The breakdown of the figure by College is as follows:

The College of Animal Science has the highest undergraduate output of 403 in the regular programme and is closely followed by College of Management Science with 397 while the College of Veterinary Medicine has the least undergraduate output of 15. In the Part-Time programme, the College of Physical Science has the highest undergraduate output of 23, while the College of Plant Science has the least undergraduate output of 3.




Fig. 3.2: Undergraduate Output by College -2014/2015 Academic Session

3.1.4 Part-Time Degree Students' Enrolment

The 2014/2015 session for the Part-time Degree Programme was cancelled to harmonise it with the academic calendar of Full-time Degree Programme. Hence, the total number of students on ground at the end of 2013/2014 session was Five Hundred and Sixty-Five (565) students.

The College of Animal Science has the highest Part-Time Degree Students' enrolment of 102, closely followed by College of Physical Science with 101, while the College of Biosciences has the least Part-Time Degree Students' enrolment of 50.

3.1.5.1 INHURD Enrolment Data

Students' enrolment data in respect of the above are represented in Fig. 3.5-3.9. There is a sharp decline in students' enrolment in Pre-Degree Science programme from 1,260 in 2013/2014 Academic session to 670 in 2014/2015 Academic session, while Pre-Degree Management Students' enrolment got increased from 293 in 2013/2014 Academic session to 483 in 2014/2015 Academic session. The Cambridge "A" Level programme has students' enrolment of 19, JUPEB "A" Level has students' enrolment of 71 while IJMB programme has students' enrolment of 70.








Fig. 3.3: Pre-Degree Science Students' Enrolment




Fig. 3.5: Cambridge, JUPEB & IJMB Students' Enrolment in 2015

3.2 Academic Staff Profile

The numerical strength of Academic Staff by Department, Rank and Gender in the year under review is 560, which is distributed across the 10 Colleges and 47 Departments.
