Figure 1: Population of Admitted Students from 2011/2012 to 2016/2017




Figure 2: 2016/2017 Academic session Enrolment for male





Figure 3: 2016 Academic session Enrolment for Female

Figure 4: Age Distribution of Undergraduate Students for 2016/2017 Academic session




Figure 5: Age Distribution of Students for 2016/2017 Academic session




Figure 6: Age Distribution of students for 2016/2017 Academic Session




Figure 7:2016/2017 Academic session Gender Trend across the Colleges




Figure 8: Undergraduate Enrolment from 2012/2013 to 2016/2017



Figure 9: Graduate Output by Class of Degree and Gender for 2016/2017 Academic Session





Figure 10: Undergraduate Graduation Pattern from 1989-2017



FUNAAB First Class graduates from 1990 - 2017



Figure 12: Geographical distribution of all students




Figure 13: Undergraduate Students' Enrolment Progression --1988 to 2017




Figure 14: FUNAAB Full-Time Undergraduate Students' Growth Rate from 1988/1989 to 2016/2017 Academic Sessions




Figure 15: Gender Distribution by College

Figure 16: Summary of Academic by Rank as at Nov.2017.



Figure 17: Academic Staff from 1988-2017



Figure 18: Pyramid Structure showing the Age Distribution of Academic Staff by Gender as at Nov.2017




Figure 19: Age Distribution of academic staff as at Nov.2017



Figure 20: Chart showing the Age distribution of Non-Teaching Staff as at Nov.2017.



Figure 21: A SQUARED DIAGRAM SHOWING THE AGE DISTRIBUTION OF JUNIOR STAFF





Figure 22: Age Distribution of Junior staff

Figure 23: FUNAAB Staff Profile as at Nov.,2017













