

**EXCERPT FROM THE NYSC RESOLUTIONS FROM THE PRE-MOBILIZATION WORKSHOP BATCHES "A" AND "C"**

The attention of our Final Year Students/Prospective Corp Members (PCMs) is hereby drawn to the following resolutions which were excerpted from the NYSC Bathes "A" and "C" Pre-mobilization Workshops held in Nasarawa (March 2019) and Enugu (September 2018):

<b>S/NO.</b>	<b>RESOLUTIONS</b>	<b>SUGGESTED ACTION</b>
1	Henceforth, Prospective Corp Members with disparity in the course of study on their Statements of Results, Certificates and Call-up letters will not be registered in the orientation camp.	Due diligence required
2	Due to the abuse of change of names by PCMs during the process of name correction and in order to enhance data integrity, the NYSC National Governing Board had made it a matter of policy that requests for change of names by PCMs will no longer be accepted except on marital ground.	Due diligence required
3	Effective from 2017, JAMB ceased to regularize admission. However, regularization of admission before 2017 will continue until the backlogs are all treated. As a matter of urgency and necessity, JAMB shall intensify effort to end regularization process in order to achieve integrity in the NYSC mobilization process.	Due diligence required
4	Evasion of service is a chargeable offence, Corp Producing Institutions (CPIs) should therefore ensure that their graduates are mobilized as and when due to participate in National Service and also to bring to their knowledge the implications of service evasion.	Due diligence required
5	Upload will no longer accept abbreviation of names, special characters and duplication of matric/JAMB numbers, while SAOs are expected to upload the full names of their Prospective Corps Members (PCMs). Matric numbers different from original matric numbers assigned will be rejected by the system.	Due diligence required
6	Effective from 19 <sup>th</sup> September, 2018, NYSC will no longer entertain offline application for name correction, removal or addition. PCMs with such problems should apply online through their dashboards for SAOs to confirm and for NYSC to view for approval. Furthermore, NYSC will no longer treat any application for correction of name, removal or addition that is not signed by the institution's Registrar.	Due diligence required

In line with the above-stated resolutions, Final Year Students/Prospective Corp Members (PCMs) are to take note and exercise due diligence before and during online registration to achieve seamless preparation for NYSC mobilization exercise.
