PREAMBLE

In accordance with the provisions of the Universities (Miscellaneous Provisions) Decree No. 11 of 1993 as amended in 1996, 2003 and 2012, the Governing Council of the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, Nigeria (FUNAAB) wishes to commence the process of appointment of the 7th substantive Vice-Chancellor. Consequently, applications are hereby invited from suitably qualified candidates for the position.

THE UNIVERSITY

The Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta was established on January 1, 1988 by the Federal Government of Nigeria as a specialized University of Agriculture. It has a land area of 10,200 hectares and it is located in Odeda Local Government Area in the North-Eastern part of Abeokuta, Ogun State, Nigeria.

The University has the mandate of teaching, research and community engagement. The University currently has a population of about 16,000 Undergraduate students, 1,500 Postgraduate students and about 2,500 Academic and Non-Teaching staff.

- must have proven record of national, international acknowledgment by academic communities through collaborations and peer-reviewed scientific publications;
- must possess proficiency in Information and Communication Technology (ICT);
- must have the ability to foster unity and progress among all stakeholders, including, students, staff, alumni and the host communities;
- must enjoy excellent physical and mental health; • must have the ability to attract resources for the much needed development of the University; and
- the successful candidate must be available to resume duty on 3rd April, 2023.

RESPONSIBILITIES
